We are very keen to get parents, grandparents and friends involved, so would absolutely love to hear from you.

<u>Invoices</u>: You should have received your invoice for the term. If you would like to discuss your invoice or if you wish to set up a payment contract to spread the cost of your child's sessions at pre-school please get in touch with our Business Manager, Zoe Bedford-Cooper <u>zoeggvp@gmail.com</u>, who will happily help with any issues you may have. If you add any sessions or lunch clubs after your initial invoice you will be invoiced separately for them.

Future Sessions for your Child(ren): Sessions now and in the future are filling up very fast to the point there may have to be a waiting list for some sessions/days, so if you are thinking of increasing your child's sessions in the next few months and have not already spoken to Jo about which days you would like then please do so as sessions are very limited.

<u>Clothing:</u> Please make sure your child(ren) have the appropriate clothes and shoes for the time of year. Named wellies (to be left at the setting), hats, coats and gloves, a spare change of clothes and waterproofs (for spending time in the Forest Fun Area and our vegetable garden) would be ideal as the weather becomes chilly and wet.

<u>Parking / Vicarage</u>: The lane adjacent to the playground is the entrance to the vicarage and they are a family of four children who also have to be dropped to school etc. Please do not park in this lane as you are

essentially blocking the way to a residence. We know parking can be tricky at times but do bear this in mind.
