This week we are continuing our theme and play surrounding the story of 'We're going on a bear hunt'. We will continue to make collages of the different scenes in the story, decorating cut out bears, swishy grass, mud and snow. We will also be singing songs with bears in. Our colour for the week is 'black'. Please encourage your child/children to look for any object or toy that is black to bring in for 'show and tell'. This week our number is 4.

<u>Grapes / Olives & Blueberries</u>: Please remember to cut your grapes, olives and blueberries in four. This is the current Health and Safety guidelines. They can completely block a child's airway and this is the simplest way to take away this risk. Grapes should be cut length ways at a very minimum, but in four is recommended. The same applies to any rounded soft fruits / vegetables.

<u>Reminder regarding nuts and sesame:</u> Can we remind all parents that no nuts of any kind or sesame are allowed in your child's lunch in setting.

<u>Naming of items:</u> Can we please request that all coats, wellies or any item your child brings to pre-school is named. A sharpie/permanent marker works well. It is sometimes difficult for staff to match coats to children in order to go outdoors and eats into valuable time outside whilst children find their coats/wellies etc.
